Describe the administrative process of getting a new user on-line:

1-. The user have to call the system and make the registration on-line, or, he/her can request the system operators to open an account for him/her.

2-. Pay the registration fee. The fee structure is described below.

What are your user fees?

Registration (one time charge): US 20.

Monthly Subscription: \$ 8.600 pesos (in local currency)
in US\$ 10.

Connect charges per hour: US\$ 4 after the first hour (one hour free per month).

Charges to receive international messages (exchange with local nodes has no charge):

\$ 70 pesos (US\$ 0.081)/KB

\$100 pesos (US\$ 0.116)/KB

US\$30 deposit that will be reimbursed when the user cancel his/her account. This applies just to users that want to use international e-mail. For nodes polling Colnodo (like CVVL, WFPNET -see below-) the deposit is US\$125.

What other networks operate in your country or region, which of these do you work with, and in what way?

Colnodo is providing international connectivity to the following networks:

- Colegio Verde de Villa de Leyva in Villa de Leyva Boyaca, CVVL. The work in environment issues. The host was installed by the South Links project of the UNDP Volunteers program.
- Cipav, in Cali Valle del Cauca. Research for Rural Development. The host was installed by Cipav with the support of Colnodo.
- WFPNET, in Bogota. World Food Program of NU. The host was installed by WFP in Bogota with the support of EcuaneX.

We are trying to connect Colnodo to some Colombian universities via Colciencias (Colciencias is a governmental Institution that works sponsoring scientific researches). The connection is working but just in one way (Colnodo->Colciencias).

Is your network fully operational?

Yes, we provide local e-mail exchange among our users and other national networks as Colegio Verde de Villa de Leyva, Cipav, World Feed Program of United Nations and Colciencias (the last one is not fully operational yet).

Colnodo's users has access to the following APC conferences: eai.news, ilsa.actualida, ilsa.comercio, ilsa.trade, nacla.report, alai.amlatina and dh.amlatina.

We have also local conferences with: national and international events of interest for the NGO community, economics indicators, ecology, children issues, national debt, newspaper clippings.

We offer on-line access to 18 databases, most of them documentation centers of the NGO's:

If not, what assistance from your contact network do you need to become fully operational?

Although we can provide the services described before, we would like to have assistance in to items: a-. establishment of a x.25 connection and b-. an internet gateway since this network will be available soon in Colombia.

Do you agree to the terms listed in the Membership of the APC document?

Yes, we do.

Are there any requirements that you currently cannot meet?

Yes.

Which are they

We cannot afford 5.000 dollars per year. We would like to apply for a subsidy of 4.000 dollars for the first year that will be revised in the second year of membership.

How do you plan to meet them? When?

Well, we think that as soon as we can regulate the income of Colnodo we can revise this requirement.

When did you first hear of APC?

I (Julian Casasbuenas) think it was during 1989. With the conference organized by Interdoc 'Information Exchange for Social Change' we started to understand much better the structure of APC. The other members of Colnodo heard about APC through Julian Casasbuenas and Miguel Peirano.

Why do you want to be an APC member?

We agree with the philosophy and intentions of APC, expressed in the APC aims.

How can APC best serve your interests?

Giving us support with technical matters to enhance our communications with APC. Providing access to the public conferences of the APC and other services like fax servers, database servers, etc.

How can you assist APC?

- * Increase contact amongst members of our network and interested parties of other APC networks in order to exchange information and experiences.
- * Disseminate scarce resources and have access to documentation and information that was previously unexploited.
- * Support research and avoid duplication of efforts by making more information available.
- * Encourage action at the grassroots level through exchange of ideas and resources.
- * Make these services available at low cost, within the financial means of the services who work with the poorest sectors of

society.

- * We are inviting the Colombian NGOs to use our system and to exchange information generated by them using the network. With this information we are planning to start some local conferences that can be converted into APC public conferences with colombian issues.
- * We can provide technical assistance to new users and/or networks in the region that want to join APC.
- * We can give APC users access to our local databases.

What difficulties do you foresee as an APC member?

Maybe that becoming an APC member we will catch the interest of too many people/organizations and we do not have yet the technical infrastructure to provide access to too many users at the same time and to receive/send large volumes of information at international level.

What are your goals for APC as a global association?

As we said before, we agree with the apc aims, and the philosophy and intentions of APC, this is we agree with the APC goals.

What is the legal structure of your network, or of the organisation that operates it if different?

Colnodo is operated by the 'Asociacion de Organizaciones No Gubernamentales para la Comunicacion Via Correo Electronico' - The Colombian Association of Non Governmental Organizations for Electronic Mail Communication, conformed by:

- Antenna Colombia.
- Asociacion de Trabajo Interdisciplinario, -Interdisciplinary Work Association- ATI.
- Escuela Nacional Sindical -National Labor School- ENS, Medellin.
- Federacion Nacional de Organizaciones de Vivienda Popular, -National Federation of Popular Housing- Fedevivienda.
- Fundacion Foro Nacional por Colombia, -National Forum for Colombia-, Foro.
- Fundacion Luis Carlos Galan, Luis Carlos Galan Foundation.

Colnodo is operated by Antenna Colombia, who is in charge of provide maintenance to the network and assist the users.

BUDGET

The project is to be self-financing. By writing up this project -budget- proposal, we hope to cover the costs of the initial investment and the operating cost for the first two years, during which period operation are likely to be more expensive due to

mounting the system and its services, publicity and training users.
